

Self-Reported Regular Use*, 1989-1997



Trends in Delaware Students' Alcohol Use by Grade







know where to get cigarettes, alcohol & Marijuana by county


Among Delaware Eighth Graders 1997





Among Delaware Eleventh Graders 1997




PERCENT RECEIVING DRUG EDUCATION Among Delaware School Students 1997








Trends in Delaware 5th Graders' Perception of Substance Use Great Risk*


Trends in Delaware 8th Graders' Perception of Substance Use Great Risk*





Past year drug use and driving by county


